

Freshman, here is a list of items we will discuss at our meeting Tuesday, September 19th at 11:00 in the Lecture Hall about homecoming week.

1. We need to think of a T-Shirt color. We should have a few colors in mind, as the other classes will also be picking a color. Since we are the “low man on the totem pole,” if another class wants our color, they get to have it. You will vote on which color you like the most, as well as second most.

2. We need to come up with a T-Shirt design. If you would like to submit a design, please email it to Mr. Dreher (ddreher@usd489.com) or Mr. Pfannenstiel (jfpfannenstiel@usd489.com) with “freshman t-shirt” as the subject. The design should be both front and back, IN ONE COLOR! It should include the word “freshmen” in its design, as well as the “class of 2021.” All submissions must be school appropriate. You will then vote on which design you like the best. Designs are due by the morning of Sept. 22nd .

3. Please know your T-Shirt Size when coming to the meeting.

4. We need two trailers for the parade.

A) One trailer should be large enough for the entire freshman class to ride on during the parade. We need this trailer for the Parade only, on October 13th, from 4-6:30. We also need a truck to pull it.

B) The second trailer is what you will build your float on. It should be a flat trailer, with a length of 12-15 feet. This trailer will be used for the entire week, starting on Sunday October 8th and will be returned by Saturday Oct 14th . We also need a truck to pull it.

5. We need a shop to build our float in. The shop needs to allow the freshman to come in during homecoming week and build the float.

Float building is only allowed during the following times.

Tuesday, October 10th from 5:30pm to 9pm

Wednesday, October 11th from 3:30pm to 6pm IF NEEDED!!!
